An enrollment fee of \$50 per child is due with this application. This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable. Please write your check to TLC Preschool and attach to this application.

Enrollment Fee: Enrollment fee is \$50 per child. This fee is due with the enrollment application. This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Adult Attendance: Attendance of an adult, with the child, is required for the entirety of each class.

Waitlisted: To add your child's name to the waitlist, you are required to complete an enrollment application and pay the \$50 application processing fee.

Tuition Payments: Tuition is due upon receipt of the monthly invoice or no later than the 10th of the month. A 15% late fee will be charged for all payments received after the 10th of the month.

Priority Enrollment: Priority enrollment is given to 1) Staff Children 2) Returning Families 3) Siblings 4) Waitlisted Children 5) New Families

Make-up days: There are no make-up days. If you take vacation during school days, or your child is absent for any other reason, you are still responsible for the monthly tuition rate.

Keeping Your Spot: If you decide to take a leave of absence from school for an extended period, you will be required to pay the tuition rate to hold your enrollment. Otherwise, the spot will be given to another child on the waitlist.

Payment Methods: TLC Preschool accepts personal checks, cashier checks or money orders.

School Closures: If TLC Preschool must close due to an emergency, full school closure due to Covid-19 or weather-related closure, we will add one additional day at the end of the school year.

Terms: Tuition is not determined by the number of days your child attends class.
It is an annual rate and is divided into 8-equal payments for your convenience. Payments are made September-April.
